### **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by President Raymond LaTorre.

#### Roll Call

Trustee Gar House was absent; however, a quorum was present. Trustee Christopher Barker arrived to the meeting at 10:25am.

## Pledge of Allegiance

All phones and electronic devices are requested to be silenced during the meeting.

At this time President LaTorre called for a moment of silence to honor Field Technician II, Timothy Gee, who suddenly passed away over the weekend. Tim was a valued member of the District for over fourteen years and will be sorely missed by his coworkers, friends and family.

## 3. REPORTS TO THE BOARD

#### a. Manager's Report:

The District's West Nile season is off to a slow start as compared to last year with the recent detection of the first WNv positive dead bird and the first positive mosquito collection pool for our District. Crews are very busy addressing high populations and virus activity in various areas. Staff will continue to follow the Mosquito Borne Disease Management Plan with enhanced surveillance and control efforts in response to positive dead birds or positive mosquito collections. The District conducted a flyover with a new vendor of approximately 50 square miles over parts of north Sacramento County to look for green swimming pools and compare to the District's previous flyovers. The goal is to see how efficient the new system would be and to test their artificial intelligence system on its ability to accurately find swimming pools and shorten the timeline from flyover to identification. The AMCA is continuing to push for appropriations to the newly passed SMASH (Strengthening Mosquito Abatement for Safety and Health) Act. The Senate appropriations committee is meeting this month to hopefully finalize the CDC budget and include funding for SMASH. We have been partnering with other public health entities to educate our lawmakers on the need for this funding. The MVCAC supported bill (AB320) that would establish the CalSury Gateway in state statute and codify existing operations will be heard in the Senate Education Committee on July 10th.

**b.** <u>Reports from District Departments:</u> Written reports were provided in the Board packet from each department. Department supervisors gave an oral presentation and were available to answer any questions.

<u>Lab/Surveillance</u>: Laboratory Director, Marcia Reed discussed department activities including mosquito abundance, EVS surveillance, studies and collaborations. *Culex pipiens* abundance is higher than the five year average while *culex tarsalis* abundance is climbing now that much of the rice is planted and temperatures are warmer. The District has collected and tested 171 dead birds

with just one bird testing positive for West Nile virus so far this season. At this time last year we had collected 210 dead birds with 23 of those testing positive for WNv. The dead bird was collected from the Elverta area with one mosquito sample pool testing positive for West Nile virus in the Florin area. Additional surveillance traps have been set in both areas. Spray evaluations related to the product trials are taking place this month. In addition, samples from catch basins will be sent to Dr. Gan for analysis as a part of the residue and resistance study.

**Ecological Management:** Ecological Management Supervisor, Marty Scholl discussed department activities including Stormwater/Drainages, Wetland Program, Planning Program, Pool Program, and the UAS Program. Staff has been monitoring and notching beaver dams in the main drainage ditch north of Hwy 5 in the Yolo Bypass and will install a pipe in the dam, if necessary. Staff has reviewed plans for and will work with appropriate staff on the City of Sacramento McKinley Water Vault project and the Army Corps of Engineers on their drainage project in the Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area. UAS treatments are being performed by Leading Edge with staff preparing to take CDPR's UAS Certification for Vector Control Technicians on August 15<sup>th</sup>. Staff has submitted six warrant applications for swimming pools technicians have not been able to gain access to in order to inspect and treat.

<u>Biological Control:</u> Fisheries Supervisor, Tony Hedley provided a written report in the Board packet. Manager Goodman noted the pictures of the new fencing that were included in the report and indicated there are plans to install more fencing like this around other ponds.

<u>Larval and Adult Control</u>: Program Coordinator, Steve Ramos reported on department activity including rice acreage, abundance responses, green swimming pools and trial work. This year there are approximately 39,133 acres of rice, 34,145 of conventional and 4,988 of organic, which is about a 16% decrease when compared to last year. Adulticiding in agricultural areas has picked up due to high abundance in the District's rice traps. Staff is continuing to work on the Sumilarv trial for catch basins and dairy lagoons.

<u>Public Outreach:</u> Public Information Officer, Luz Robles reported on department activities including Advertising and Media, Events, Government Affairs, and Repellent and Materials Distribution. The District launched the children's Mosquito Buster Squad website with interactive games and activities geared towards reinforcing our Fight the Bite prevention messages. The site will be promoted to teachers through social media and school presentations. The advertising campaign is in full swing with messages airing on radio and television stations, billboards and train ads. Staff will be attending the Pear Fair in July and are distributing repellent as requested for local events including National Night Out in August.

## a. Manager's Report

The District's West Nile season is the slowest one on record since the introduction to our area in 2004. We continue to follow the Districts Mosquito Borne Disease Management Plan with enhanced surveillance and control efforts in response to positive dead birds or positive mosquito collections.

The spread of *Aedes aegypti* is getting closer to the District boundaries with San Joaquin and Stanislaus counties finding the invasive mosquito. The laboratory staff are continuing our extensive trapping program to monitor their status within our boundaries.

The District has been contacted by US EPA for a site visit to discuss our operations and mosquito control challenges in California. They are scheduled for a visit during the week of September 9<sup>th</sup>.

The MVCAC supported bill, AB 320, which would create and codify the California Mosquito Surveillance and Research Program, was heard and passed out of the Senate Appropriations Committee on August 12<sup>th</sup>.






Culex pipiens in abundance traps (NJLT, LCKR, GT):






Encephalitis virus surveillance (EVS) – Mosquitoes – EVS trapping with CO<sub>2</sub> baited and Gravid traps is continuing. We have currently tested 4047 mosquito pools (samples) and have found 26 to be positive. 23 positive pools are from Sacramento County and 3 are from Yolo County. In addition, trapping being done by UC Davis has found three additional pools from Yolo County. Response trapping is being conducted around the positive sites.

**Encephalitis virus surveillance (EVS)** – Sentinel Chickens – We have not detected any seroconversions in our chickens yet this season.

**Encephalitis virus surveillance (EVS)** – Dead Birds – We have tested 178 dead bird samples and found 14 positives, all of the positives are in Sacramento County. Seven of the positive birds were California Scrub Jays, and there were 2 each of American Crows and Yellow-billed Magpies.

**Exotic/Invasive Species Surveillance** – We have trapped at over 100 distinct locations, 80 of these being new sites utilizing BG Sentinel traps baited with the BG-Lure and CO<sub>2</sub>.

**Tick and Lyme disease surveillance** – Tick flagging will begin again in October.

**BG Counter Traps** – These traps continue to be utilized in the adult surveillance program for our rice habitats. We are also collaborating with a student from UC Davis who is studying the impact of weather conditions on mosquito flight activity. They have been collecting and verifying the trap counts of several of our rice field traps. The data from our collections and theirs is recorded and the traps continue to show good results in terms of the automatic counts versus actual counts in the rice field traps. The urban/suburban traps show more variability, which is not unexpected due to lower mosquito activity found in this habitat in general.

**Mosquito Resistance Testing** – We have completed several Cx pipiens bottle bioassays, and will be working on Cx tarsalis bottle bioassays before the end of the season.

**Non-WNV Disease Response Surveillance** – We just received a report for an imported malaria case. We will be setting traps looking for any *Anopheles* spp. mosquitoes which may be present.

### **District Studies –**

**WDG WALS study** – We have completed our WALS study for the season and are working on summarizing our findings of its effectiveness.

**Product Trials** – We have completed one Merus 3.0 trial and are working on scheduling another trial. The initial results are encouraging. We have also completed two comparison trials of Pyronyl Oil Concentrate #525 and Pyronyl Crop Spray. We have also completed a Deltagard truck ULV trial. A Dibrom trial is also being planned to evaluate the effectiveness of Dibrom. Dibrom contains the same active ingredient as Trumpet EC.

**Vectobac 12AS via rotary atomizers** – This trial is still being planned for the future.

#### Collaborations -

Catch Basin Residue and Resistance study – We have performed two sampling events and sent catch basin water and sediment samples to Dr. Gan at UC Riverside for analysis. The basins sampled were in the Woodland and Elk Grove areas.

**Biogents BGI Project** – We are looking forward to again working on this new trap design this season if a prototype becomes available.

**Biogents Pro trap** – We have received the new traps and are in the process of designing a study to compare them against our usual  $CO_2$  baited EVS traps. We are working with California Department of Public Health staff on the design of this evaluation.

**Sugar Bait Project** – We have begun deploying sugar wicks to the field in the areas where West Nile virus has been detected in either mosquito pools or dead bird samples. We have detected virus in two sugar wicks samples. Below are pictures of the wicks.





**PipPop Project -** We have concluded our collection of specimens of potential populations of *Culex pipiens* f. *molestus*. We will be submitting samples to a researcher at Princeton University for genetic analysis.

# **ECOLOGICAL MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT Monthly Report for the August 2019 Board Meeting**

## **Storm Water / Drainages Program**

<u>Hansen Ranch:</u> Staff is working with the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) maintenance division to remove beaver dams and stream sediment blockages within the Natomas East Main Drainage Canal(NEMDC) in hopes of reducing standing water within Hansen Ranch. DWR has rented equipment to help with the stream maintenance and has requested assistance from the District to monitor the water levels within Hansen Ranch.





## **Wetland Program**

Staff has started working with the local duck clubs and wildlife area managers to plan fall flooding dates and acreages.

Staff attended a meeting at the Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area headquarters in Davis to plan fall flooding start times for the private land owners that utilize the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) water and roads located south of the Wildlife Area in the lower Yolo Bypass. At the meeting Yolo County provided an update on DWR's Yolo Bypass Fish Restoration and Passage Project as well as the Yolo Bypass Drainage Improvement Projects that may be affecting local landowners. Staff will continue to be involved as the planning process progresses to help identify potential conflicts with District operations.

<u>Yolo Flyway Farms:</u> Staff met on site with representatives from DWR and CDFW regarding the new freshwater tidal wetland located in the Lower Yolo Bypass. DWR offered full access and support for the new wetland area, and will help the District identify mosquito breeding areas and will look for solutions once the problems have been identified.

<u>Lower Yolo Ranch:</u> DWR is working with Westlands Water District to develop a continuous freshwater tidal habitat, connecting to the recently completed Yolo Flyway Farms tidal wetland mentioned above. DWR will share with the District design plans as they become available and is seeking input to avoid any mosquito breeding issues. A rough restoration plan is included at the end of this report.

## **UAS Program**

The California Department of Pesticide Regulation (CDPR) has released the highly anticipated UAS Pest Control Certification Program for Vector Control applications. Marty has been studying and will be taking the test August 15<sup>th</sup>. In anticipation of getting an Unmanned Pest Control Aircraft Pilot Certificate, staff has begun calibrations of the DJI Agras spray UAS. A new granular hopper has also been purchased, and will be tested and calibrated once received.

Leading Edge Aerial Technologies Inc. has larvicided by UAS just under 1400 acres this season covering a diverse range of mosquito source habitats. More treatments are scheduled for summer and into Fall Flooding. Departmental staff has been instrumental in helping to coordinate product inventories, order creation and reporting as well as working with Control Operations to delineate application areas.

Leading Edge also completed an aerial larvicide application over Willow Springs, a dense riparian area off of Marsh Hawk Dr. within the City of Folsom. This marked the first complete area wide application performed in this area as ground vegetation has prevented effective ground based treatments.



Staff continues to utilize aerial UAS imagery to monitor locations with a known potential of standing water in and around areas with limited access. Staff assisted DWR with finding equipment access points within the NEMDC, as well as helping District technicians find standing water on Delta island properties.

## **Pool Program**

Staff applied for five individual backyard pool warrants and one warrant with a list of eight properties. All warrants were posted and served with the assistance of the appropriate local law enforcement present. Staff have been conducting follow-up inspections on the properties that said they would drain or fix their green swimming pool as well as continuing to attempt inspections on newly received pool locations.



# BIOLOGICAL CONTROL Monthly Report for August 2019 Board Meeting

The District stocked 1,822 lbs. of fish in the month of July. This number is up 23% from July's 2018 number of 1,479 lbs. The vast majority of the fish usage was in the District's rice fields with over 1,790 lbs. as the department worked on stocking as many fields as possible. The department works extensively with the rice growers and communicates regularly with field staff to evaluate every rice field individually for larval density, historical treatments, and proximity to dense residential neighborhoods. Utilizing this data, the timing and stocking rate of all fields is determined. These numbers are anticipated to continue through the first two weeks of August as the need to stock the late season planted rice fields will be required.

The department also continued to gather weekly data for all of our ongoing projects including evaluating pond dye versus traditional fertilization, crayfish control, and the use of solar aerators on dissolved oxygen levels. Daily activities such as medical treatments and tank cleaning were also performed to maintain the high quality of our fish population.




Left photo shows fish seine with an abundance of crayfish. Right photo is a red eared slider eating fish. They can become stuck in our nets.

# CONTROL OPERATIONS Monthly Report for August 2019 Board Meeting

The aerial larviciding program was in full swing for July with over 400 individual sources being treated in both Counties combined. The District has transitioned to granular larvicide treatment on rice growing areas in order to penetrate the thicker rice canopy. Aerial adulticiding in agriculture areas has also picked up for the season with over 200,000 acres being treated in both Counties combined; at this time in 2018 the District had treated just over 230,000 acres of agricultural areas. An aerial adulticide trial for Merus 3.0 has been performed over the organic rice fields in the Conaway Ranch with promising results, further evaluation will continue throughout this season. Further aerial evaluations on pyrethrum products were performed in July including Pyronyl 525 and Pyronyl Crop Spray.

Field evaluations of the MGK product Sumilary 0.5G in dairy lagoons is ongoing with at least one lagoon showing control for over 4 weeks at this time, this evaluation will continue through the season.

# PUBLIC INFORMATION AND EDUCATION Monthly Report for the August 2019 Board Meeting

## **National Night Out Repellent and Materials Distribution:**

A press release was issued announcing free repellent wipes available for National Night Out. Many neighborhood association and service organizations including the City of Sacramento Neighborhood Services and Parks and Recreation Department took advantage of the District's repellent distribution. In addition, we participated in a National Night Out event organized by the South Land Park Neighborhood Association. The event was very well attended and included participation of local elected officials and law enforcement agencies in addition to community members.

## **Events:**

August is a very busy event month with six scheduled events. This year we added the Galt Balloon Festival to our list of events, a unique event held very early in the morning. Our booth was well received and we were able to speak to a variety of residents including those in neighboring counties. We also participated in the Yolo County Children's Alliance Back to School Health Fair. This was an event that was very well attended by many ethnic groups and it gave us the opportunity to distribute repellent and speak to many people that we don't ordinarily reach at other events. Other events we attended included the UC Davis Master Gardener, five days at the Yolo County Fair and the Elk Grove Multicultural Festival.

## **Presentations:**

This month two presentations were given. The first was at the Hood Franklin Neighborhood Association where attendees were very interested in learning more about our District services and operations especially since they are so close to Stonelakes Refuge and other mosquito breeding habitats. The presentation was well received and everyone appreciated the repellent and materials that were shared. The second presentation was part of a conference organized by the Department of Water Resources and it was geared towards employees of the agency and other conference participants.

#### Media

As a result of the first activity detected in Yolo County we did have some media coverage including a variety of print articles in the Sacramento Bee, Davis Enterprise and Daily Democrat. In addition, the local ABC10 television station had a report focusing on how West Nile virus can be a very under reported disease.

### Advertising

The advertising campaign continues to be in full swing and our Fight the Bite messages are airing consistently across radio and television stations. The media schedule is in flights so that our messages are being rotated across stations and this ensures a constant presence at all times throughout the media market. In addition to these commercials we also have billboards and bus ads.

## 4. Status of West Nile Virus Activity and District Response

## **Staff Report:**

The District continues to follow the Mosquito and Mosquito Borne Disease Management Plan which highlights the steps that personnel take in responding to high abundance or infections in the mosquito population. When a dead bird or mosquito is found to have been infected with West Nile virus, lab personnel enhance surveillance efforts around the location to determine the potential spread of the detection. Control operation personnel then conduct a radius of both larval and adult sources to help reduce the number of mosquitoes in the area and to reduce the risk of transmission to the population. The District then continues to monitor the area to determine the geographic extent of the infection and to see if the number of infections decreases from the effort of the control personnel. If infections persist in the area, then more aggressive measures are considered.

The District has experienced a mild WNv year compared to previous years with few ground based adulticide treatments needed in urban/suburban areas. To date, no aerial adulticiding has been required over congested areas to quickly interrupt the transmission cycle of WNv. However, the District has maintained its adulticide activity by air and ground in rice growing and agricultural areas to reduce populations and to prevent migration from these areas to the population centers of the District.

Across the State, the testing effort has remained consistent this year in comparison to 2018. While there are approximately 700 more mosquito pool positives this year compared to last year, the foci of activity in 2019 has been in Tulare(563), Riverside(482), and Fresno Counties(276) accounting for over 80% of the 1647 positive mosquito collections to date. Last year the majority of the positives at this time came from Placer, San Joaquin, Sacramento and Yolo Counties. In contrast to the mosquitoes, West Nile positive dead birds are down from last year with only 58 birds testing positive so far this year compared to the 284 in 2018. There has been a 30% decline in the number of dead birds being reported to the hotline this year versus 2018.
