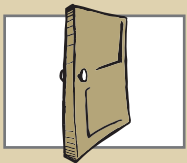
Dress appropriately when going outside!

the Mosquito Life Cycle

Mosquitoes grow in water and go through four separate stages as they become adults.



Egg Raft



Larva



Pupa



Adult

that female mosquitoes bite



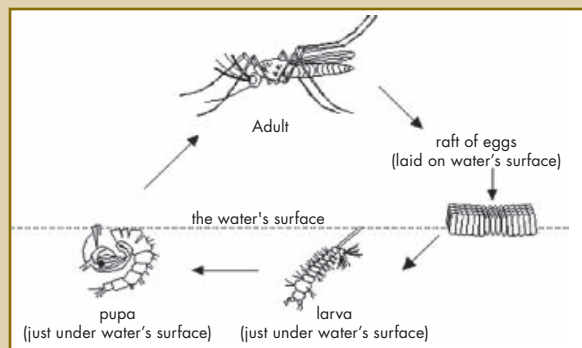
that female mosquitoes need blood to lay eggs

A MOSQUITO BUSTER KNOWS...

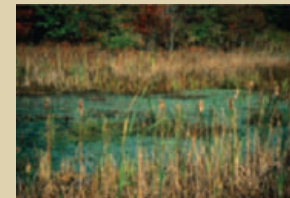
where mosquitoes grow

Tires and toys



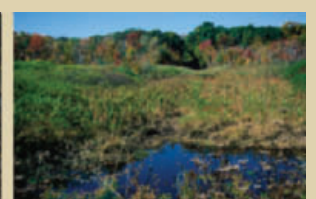
Ponds and dirty swimming pools
